Additional Document Checklist Study Permit



Get ready and apply online.

This checklist should be used in conjunction with the [IMM 5483](#) Document Checklist for a Study Permit.

If your documents are in a language other than English or French, you must include a certified translation.

After submission of all required documents, you may be required to attend an interview.

Any preparations you make, such as paying administration or tuition fees, are done entirely at your own risk.

Do not finalize travel plans unless you have received your visa. A parent or legal guardian will sign for a minor child.

If any of the required documents listed below are missing, the processing of your application could be delayed.

False statements or submission of fraudulent documents will result in immediate refusal and possible ban from Canada for 5-years.

You must reside outside of Canada when you apply.

You must submit the following items:

Two recent passport photographs for each applicant:

- [Temporary Resident Visa application photograph specifications](#)

A valid passport or travel document for yourself and each family member:

- Upload a copy of the information page of your passport when you apply online.
- ***If you are approved***, you must then send us your original passport.

Note: Your passport must be valid for at least **6 months**.

Previous passports showing travel history.

Academic Documents:

- Present academic standing (up-to-date transcripts);
- WAEC, SSCE or NECO results;
- Postsecondary transcripts;
- All certificates and diplomas. You must provide evidence of all current and past education, including the street name and address of ALL previous educational institutions that you attended; and
 - include NYSC certificate, if applicable.

Proof of sufficient funds:

- Please refer to the [IRCC website](#) for the current financial requirements.
- Evidence includes:
 - certified bank statements or financial investments with past six months' history including your submission month or ending one month prior;
 - you may include a MyBankStatement ticket issued by your financial institution, which should contain both a ticket ID and a passcode;
 - you must also show a reliable source of funds for the duration of your academic program;



- you may also submit financial documents related to a sponsor including valid confirmation of employment, pay slips, salary bank statements, valid pension plan or proof of income from rental properties or stocks, bonds and other financial documents from the sponsor;
- if your funds are from a source other than you or an immediate family member (parents or spouse), you should provide proof of relationship and an explanation for how that person will support you financially.

Note: If the source of funds originates from your business, submit official business registration documents along with evidence of ownership.

Scholarships or any financial assistance:

- From the school or award from a government or other funding agency must be presented on official letterhead stating the full amount of the award, its duration and any governing conditions;
- There must also be evidence that the Scholarship Program exists.
